



# COM-UHP/CCTS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

## Overview:

The College of Medicine Urban Health Program (COM UHP) and Center for Clinical and Translational Sciences (CCTS) have partnered to provide UIC health science graduate and professional students, undergraduates, and high school scholars with an intensive summer research experience that provides an introduction to health equity issues through the conduct of clinical and translational research and community engaged research.

## The program includes:

- 8-week summer research experience under the mentorship of a UIC researcher/team of researchers
- 3 ½ days of intensive training and certification in clinical and translational research
- Weekly journal club
- End of program poster and oral presentation
- Ongoing participation in research education opportunities
- Optional longitudinal mentorship and professional development

## Eligibility:

- Graduate and professional health science students in good academic standing are eligible to participate.
- Highly motivated undergraduates, high school juniors and seniors interested in pursuing careers in the health sciences (must have a minimum GPA of 3.0).
